### **Golytely Split Dose Prep**

It is important to follow these instructions exactly as written. If your colon is not completely cleaned out the doctor will not be able to see and you may have to repeat the prep and procedure at another time.

**Procedure date and time:** \_\_\_\_\_

- **Wilmington Health ASC, Endoscopy Unit, 3rd floor**
- **NHRMC Endoscopy Unit**
- **Wilmington SurgCare (Will call you with your time)**

#### **What to buy:**

- Take GoLyte prescription to pharmacy (If it was not already sent by our office) and have it filled a few days prior to your exam.
- **Dulcolax (Bisacodyl) 5mg laxative tablets.** You will need 4 tablets. These will need to be purchased over the counter.

#### **The day before your procedure:**

- **You will be on a clear liquid diet all day. NO SOLID FOODS UNTIL AFTER YOUR PROCEDURE!**
- In the morning, mix the GoLyte and refrigerate.
- **Please drink large volumes of clear liquids throughout the day to avoid dehydration and ensure a good prep.**
- **You may have:**
  - Water, tea, black coffee, sodas, clear broths, apple juice, white grape juice, cranberry juice, popsicles, slushies, italian ice, Hi-C, Kool-Aid, Jell-O and hard candy.
  - **NO red, orange or purple**
- **Do NOT have:**
  - Meat, milk, cream, pudding, fudgesicles, sherbert, fruit bars, fruit or fruit topping, cream soups, any juice containing pulp (orange, tomato, grapefruit)
- **At 4:00 pm** take 4 Dulcolax tablets with 2 glasses of clear liquids.
- **At 6:00 pm** begin drinking the GoLyte. Drink 8 ounces (1 cup) every 15 minutes until you have had half of the GoLyte (8 cups).
- Many patients report that it is helpful to use a straw to drink the liquid. You may also put a piece of hard candy in your mouth while drinking to help with the flavor.
- If you become nauseated while drinking the GoLyte, you may need to take a break, but you will need to resume drinking the prep.
- You may continue to have clear liquids until **4 hours** before your scheduled procedure time.

## GoLyteLy Split Dose Prep cont.

### The morning of your procedure:

- Start drinking the 2nd half of the GoLyteLy **6 hours** before your scheduled procedure time. Drink 8 ounces every 15 minutes until you have finished the GoLyteLy.
- You need to take your usual medication with only SIPS of water at least **4 hours** prior to your scheduled procedure time.
- **NOTHING by mouth for at least 4 hours** prior to your procedure(s). This includes chewing gum, mints, hard candy, etc. For your safety, failure to comply with this will result in cancellation of your procedure(s).

### Diabetic Patients:

### Important Information:

- **Children under the age of 18 are not allowed in the Endoscopy Recovery Room.**
- It tends to be cold in our office, we encourage you to wear a thick pair of socks to keep warm.
- You will need to bring a form of payment for your copay or deductible. Please leave all other valuable, including jewelry at home. If you do bring a purse, please have your driver keep it for you during your procedure(s).

### YOU CANNOT DRIVE YOURSELF HOME!

Following discharge from our center, you will be transported by wheelchair to your vehicle. **A responsible, licensed driver of at least 18 years of age must be present upon your arrival and remain in the building during your procedure until it is time to drive you home.** It is recommended that someone remains with you throughout the day. The anesthesia medication you receive during your procedure makes driving dangerous and illegal. **We cannot legally release you to drive. You will not be able to drive the rest of the day. You cannot take a taxi home.**
